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ORDER:

In the reference 3rd read above, the Chief Executive Officer, Society for Elimination of Rural Poverty, A.P., Hyderabad has stated that Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups in A.P. have represented that as they are living in remote areas, having subsistence livelihood and tend to age faster because of the difficult working conditions and requested to consider and reduce the age limit from 65 to 50 years to become eligible for sanction of new pensions to vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs). The Chief Executive Officer, SERP has requested the Government to reduce the age limit from 65 years to 50 years in respect of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs) to enable them to get pensions keeping in view of their health conditions and less life expectancy.

2. Government after careful examination of the matter have decided and order to reduce the age limit from 65 to 50 years to become eligible to get pensions only in respect of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs) keeping in view of their health conditions, Social economic backwardness besides relative isolation and less life expectancy. The MPDOs are responsible in identifying the eligible individuals of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs) through Village Level Pension Committees in light of the age relaxation and upload the pensioner particulars through Social Security Pension website.

3. The Chief Executive Officer, SERP and the District Collectors / Project Officers of the ITDAs are requested to issue necessary instructions to the Mandal Parishad Development Officer (MPDOs) concerned accordingly for effective implementation of the Scheme.
