ORDER

In the references 1st and 2nd cited, 71.96 lakh Social Security Pensions have been sanctioned in various categories by Government. Over a period of time, vacancies have arisen due to death, migration, elimination of bogus cases and conversion of pensions to Abhaya Hastam etc. As on 1st July 2010, 66.51 lakh pensions are being disbursed leaving 5.45 lakh vacancies.

2. The Chief Executive Officer, Society for Elimination of Rural Poverty, vide his reference cited 3rd above, stated that during the Praja Padham programme, 3.89 lakh applications have been received requesting for sanction of pensions. All these applications have been verified by MPDOs at field level; and cross-checked with the ration card database and the existing pensions list to arrive at genuine cases. The Chief Executive Officer, SERP informed that the following 4 stage verification has been done on all these applications by comparing the details of the applicant with that of the ration card database (which has been cleaned up recently after a detailed de-duplication and door-to-door survey):

Stage 1: The list was compared with the sanitized ration card database and all applications with invalid ration cards were removed.

Stage 2: All duplicate entries in the ration card database have been removed.

Stage 3: Verified whether the name of the applicant has figured in the ration card or not. All applications where applicant's name is not in the ration card were removed.

Stage 4: They were compared with the existing pensioners' database for removing duplicates.

This exercise has been done in 15 districts (except 5 Bye-election districts; and Anantapur, Kurnool & YSR Dts for which no proposal has been received) and it was proposed that 1,27,928 applicants found genuine may be sanctioned pension in the available vacancies keeping the State as a unit.

Government after careful examination of the proposal of CEO SERP, approved the system of verification followed; and permitted sanction of pension to 1,27,928 applicants (as per the district-wise list enclosed at **Annexure**) in various categories of Social Security Pensions in relaxation of the erstwhile district-wise distribution communicated earlier where needed.

4. The Chief Executive Officer, Society for Elimination of Rural Poverty, is requested to ensure that all these applicants found eligible are paid pension with effect from 1st August 2010.
